Plants will include but not limited to, grasses, sedges, hostas, columbine, lantanas, turks cap, coreopsis, rosemary, salvias, sedums and many more perennial varieties for sun and shade gardens.

We will also have a select assortment of Japanese Maples, in both red and green leaved varieties, in 3, 6 and 10-gallon sizes. Also available, a few larger specimen trees as well. There will also be a selection of dwarf Deodora Cedars, purple Smoke Trees, Rose of Sharons and Serpentine Blue Atlas Cedars in 5 and 6-gallon pots.

This year we are also pleased to add a selection of unusual evergreen shrubs to accent your garden from variegated boxwood to plum yews to Ruby Slipper Oakleaf Hydrangeas. Also this year we will get in some rare and unusual specimen trees such as Twisty Baby Locust, Summer Chocolate Mimosa, several varieties of Gingko trees and weeping red buds. MARTINEZ/MONK GARDEN – 8802 Daytonia Avenue

This garden designed by landscape architect David Ralston was installed in concert with the final construction phase of this new modern style home. The home was designed by architect Charles Bobo and constructed by brothers Amir and Adam Hamghalam. The plants uniquely compliment the contemporary open design of the home and when larger and more mature the plants should combine to create a comfortable, private, inviting outdoor living space. The back yard is scattered with plants that thrive in the Texas climate. The fence line is camouflaged with Loquat and Crossvine. Multiple Desert Willows provide a back drop for the outdoor fire pit which is surrounded by Gulf Muhly grass and Plum Yew hinting of a more xeriscape design influence. Finally, the view from the interior of the home, through the generous glass doors to the backyard passes through strategically planted Contorted Filberts (Harry Lauder's Walking Sticks, Corkscrew Hazelnut). The unique "curvy" nature of this plant's woody stems, when larger and more mature, will undoubtedly create a distinctive filter through which to view the back yard from inside the home.

THE CHANTILIS GARDEN — 8722 Daytonia

Wander from the unassuming, xeriscaped front yard, up the black tejas drive to peek in the greenhouse and see the raised vegetable and herb planters. Cross through the cheerful and artistic metal and glass fence into the backyard oasis. You will see perennials, xeriscape plantings, roses, orchids, and more raised container vegetables and herbs. The fence was created from old galvanized metal. A swell was made from rocks, minerals and glass to assist with drainage. There are several seating areas and a recessed area that was created from railroad ties. That area doubles as a fire pit gathering spot in the winter and houses a watering trough "pool" in the summer. Grace, the largest southern catalpa tree in Texas, towers over the property. Prayer flags, glow in the dark pebbles that adorn the crushed granite pathways, crystals, and slag glass create a magical feel in this unique oasis.

All three areas have shade beds and colorful container gardens. The cozy side yard gets the most sun. It has a seating area under a surface rust steel pergola surrounded by exotic succulents (Don't miss the Scottie dog topiary.) Stepping through the steel gate into the back, it is easy to see that this is an artist's yard. The backyard is a brand new garden with ground cover and hardscape foot paths artfully designed by Blue Ribbon Lady landscaping. It is a garden made to mesh seamlessly with the rustic modern architecture of the home. This backyard area features a variety of full shade plants under the canopy of ancient Pecans.
